In consideration of being permitted the use of a non-highway vehicle on streets of the Village of Steeleville, Randolph County, Illinois, Releasor, being of lawful age, for himself/herself and his/her personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next, of kin, hereby releases, waives, discharges and covenants not to sue the Village of Steeleville, Randolph County, Illinois, its officers, agents and employees, all hereinafter for convenience referred to as "Releasees", from all liability to the Releasor, his/her personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin, and from every claim, demand, action or right of action, of whatsoever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, for all loss or damage, or any claim or damage therefore, on account of injury to the person or property, or resulting in the death of Releasor, whether caused by the alleged conditions of the Village streets or the negligence of any party resulting from, or occurring by reason of, Releasor's operation of, or occurring while the Releasor is operating a non-highway vehicle on roadways under the jurisdiction of the Village of Steeleville, Randolph County, Illinois, or any activities in connection with such use, whether by negligence or other cause.

Releasor agrees to indemnify Releasees, and each of them, from any loss, liability, damage or cost Releasees may incur due to the operation by Releasor of a non-highway vehicle within the corporate limits of the Village of Steeleville, Randolph County, Illinois.

Releasor agrees that this release, waiver and indemnity is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Illinois, and if any portion of this release is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance will, notwithstanding, continue in full force and effect.

Releasor understands that the Village has an Ordinance governing the use of non-highway vehicles on Village streets and hereby agrees to conform with all requirements of the Village ordinances at all times. He/she has read said Ordinance and the "Rules Concerning Alternate Transportation for the Village of Steeleville", and by signature below acknowledges that he/she will comply with the Ordinance and said Rules as well as all of the applicable traffic laws of the State of Illinois at all times when operating a non-highway vehicle on Village streets.

Releasor further states that he/she has carefully read the above Release, knows the contents of the Release, and signs this Release as his/her own free act.

Releasor further states that he/she is familiar with the safe and proper operation of a non-highway vehicle and that he/she will operate said non-highway vehicle in a safe manner.

Releasor further acknowledges that the terms of this Release are contractual and not a mere recital.

RULES CONCERNING NON-HIGHWAY VEHICLE OPERATION

All persons wishing to operate a non-highway vehicle on Village streets must ensure compliance with the following rules:

- 1. Must have a valid Non-Highway Vehicle Permit. All permits expire on December 31st.
- 2. Must obey all traffic laws of the State of Illinois and the Village of Steeleville.
- 3. Must be operated only on Village streets, except where prohibited.
- 4. May only be operated on streets/roadways that have a posted speed limit of thirty-five (35) miles per hour or less.
- 5. Proof of current liability insurance shall be in the non-highway vehicle at all times while being operated on Village streets and must be presented upon request.
- **6.** Headlights and taillights must be illuminated at all times when a non-highway vehicle is being operated on Village streets.
- 7. A person who is operating or who is in actual physical control of a non-highway vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs is subject to 625 ILCS 5/11-500 through 625 ILCS 5/11-502.
- **8.** Non-highway vehicles shall not be operated on sidewalks in the Village or places other than on streets and parking areas.
- 9. All operators of a non-highway vehicle must adhere to the child restraint-laws pursuant to the Illinois Compiled Statutes.
- **10.** Any operator or passenger of a non-highway vehicle must-be in a sitting position and wearing a seatbelt while the vehicle is in motion.
- 11. A person is not eligible to operate a non-highway vehicle upon any street, roadway or highway within the corporate limits of the Village unless he or she has a valid driver's license issued in his or her name by the Secretary of State.
- 12. Non-highway vehicles may not be operated on streets, highways and roads located in the Village that are under the jurisdiction of the Illinois Department of Transportation, or any Village street that the Village has determined to be unsafe for non-highway vehicles to travel on. At this time these streets include the following:
 - (A) East Broadway St. (IL Route 4/150)
 - (B) West Broadway St. (IL Route 4/150)
- 13. A person may make a direct crossing of a street, road or highway under the jurisdiction of the Illinois Department of Transportation, or a Village street deemed unsafe for non-highway vehicles at an intersection with another public street, road or highway on which the operation of non-highway vehicles are permitted. Except at the following intersection(s):
 - (A) Broadway St. (IL Route 4/150) at Sparta St.



Non-Highway Vehicle Equipment

All non-highway vehicles must be equipped as follows:

- 1. Steering apparatus
- 2. Tires
- 3. Brakes
- 4. Rearview mirror
- 5. Red reflectorized warning devices in the front and rear
- 6. Slow moving emblem (as required of other vehicles in 625 ILCS 5/12-709) on the rear
- 7. An orange pennant/flag displayed on a rod or antennae three (3) feet above the top frame of the vehicle
- 8. Headlight that emits a white light visible from a distance of five hundred (500) feet to the front
- 9. Tail lamp that emits a red light visible from at least one hundred (100) feet from the rear
- 10. Brake lights
- 11. Turn signals
- 12. Seat belts
- 13. Windshield
