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# Swimming Pool/Hot tub/Spa Information Sheet

#### Frequently asked questions:

## Do I need a permit?

Yes, if the wall of the pool is over 18 inches in height, a permit is required. This can be applied for at Village Hall. A minimum fee will be collected.

#### Do I need a fence?

Yes, barriers such as fences and walls are required for pools that have wall height of 18 inches or more. The pool area must be completely contained within these barriers. The specific requirements are as follows:

- The top of the fence must be a minimum of 48 inches. Above ground pool walls 42 inches in height can serve as a barrier provided a removable ladder or a ladder that locks in the upright position is installed.
- Openings in the barrier cannot allow passage of a 4 inch sphere.
- Any door within a wall of the residence that allows direct access to the pool enclosure must armed with an audible alarm.
- Any gate must be self-closing and self-locking.
- A temporary fence is not allowed; for example the orange plastic fence used at construction sites.

# Are there any specific location requirements?

Yes, pools, hot tubs and spas are referred to as accessory structures. This means they must meet the zoning requirements of the area where they will be located.

- Minimum distance to the side yard is 10 feet, to the rear yard is 10 feet. On a corner lot, the side will be a minimum of 25 feet.
- No utility line can be overhead.
- Cannot be placed over a utility easement.
- Cannot be located in a front yard.

## Are there any specific electrical requirements?

Yes, a dedicated ground fault circuit is required for the pump. Also, a convenience outlet that is GFI protected is required within 20 feet of a pool, hot tub or spa.

#### Will I need an inspection?

Yes, an inspection by the Zoning Administrator will take place after the pool is installed.

## Can I install this myself?

Yes, an individual can install this his/herself if capable of doing so. A Contractor may also do so, but any Contractor conducting business within the Village of Steeleville is required to have a Contractor's License (this can be obtained at Village Hall).

# What are the location of my property lines?

It is the responsibility of the property owner to locate the property lines.

## What if I don't comply with all the rules on pools?

The Village of Steeleville's Code of Ordinances regulates this under Division IV – GENERAL PENALTY, making any violations punishable in Court if brought to your attention by the Code Enforcement Officer and you fail to comply within a reasonable given time.

## What's my next step?

- Fill out a permit application.
- Complete a site plan

This will be a "bird's eye view" drawing of the property where the pool will be located, giving the dimensions of the property, location of all buildings and where the pool will be located showing existing power lines.

#### Why so many rules?

The Village of Steeleville has adopted these guide lines from the International Building Codes. Due to the fact of so many dangers and hazards from bodies of water, many of these rules are enforced to protect the safety of small children.

These guidelines are not a comprehensive presentation of all of the ordinances involved in placing, erecting or constructing a pool, hot tub or spa.
